

Club membership is at an all time high and consequently our courts are getting busier. Under the Club rules a member may personally introduce a guest to play during the year. Guests may not be introduced more than three times in any calendar year. A member of the Club must form one opponent in the game in which a guest takes part. Blackheath Squash Club is run as a "notfor-profit" organisation run by volunteers. and all funds received by the club, including membership fees and light fees are fed back in to the running of the club.

We rely on these fees to maintain and develop the club and courts, and these fees have helped with the recent building works to replace the roof and the proposed works in March to replace the court floors

IMPORTANT NEWS! MAINTENANCE WORK MARCH 2024


The club is investing in new floors for the two courts at the club. This this work is scheduled for the week commencing 4th March 2024 which will mean that the courts will be closed for around a week.



The work will include repainting and filling minor holes in the court walls and the replacement of the front tins. The work is likely to take around a week to complete and we have blocked the courts on the booking sytem so they cannot be booked while the work is scheduled.

We will advise members by email when the work is completed and the courts are available for booking.
