

Work has now taken place to replace the court floors, refresh the court walls and install two new front lights on each court.



The new court floors can be slippery as they bed in, so please take care!

There are clean dry floor mops in the corridor (the blue and red mops), so if you find the floor too dusty/slippery please use these to clean it up. The dust arises from playing on the new floors, so it will take a while before it dies down.

Over sixty members at Blackheath have now linked their league results from the MyCourts system to SquashLevels. This means that every time you log a result in your league game, and your opponent has also linked to SquashLevels, your ranking will change based on the results. If you enter the scores the ranking will be even more accurate and this means your ranking can improve even if you lose 3-0! **EVERY POINT COUNTS!**

Players who are already linked to <u>SquashLevels</u> have a "1" next to their name on the box league listing in the MyCourts booking system so you can check whether your opponent has registered. Once registered you can unlock your global ranking and it's also free to register!

The player with the most improved ranking in February was Rowan Moss whose ranking improved by 12%, Congratulations Rowan!

Overall fifteen club members recently saw an improvement, so the leagues at Blackheath are very competitive. <u>SquashLevels</u> is very simple to set up and a great way to track your progress. We also had a problem with the floors lifting due to the expansion exceeding the expansion gaps put in on installation. The contractor has revisited and cut bigger expansion gaps on the right hand side of both courts. These gaps are quite large laying on the new floors, so it will take a while with the expectation that over time the floors will expand and bed down to fill them.
