REFURBISHMENT WORKS AT THE CLUB

Refurbishment works are scheduled to take place in early September. Work to update the upstairs balcony area are due to take place and include rewiring the upstairs area, repainting the area, removal of the wired glass separating the courts from the balcony to create a more open viewing area on both courts, and removal of the old bar and kitchen structure to create a more pleasant and open space for members. We are also hoping to replace the old furniture with modern tables and chairs.

This will mean that we will need to close the club and courts for a while during the works, which are currently scheduled to start on Monday 2nd September 2024 and last for approximately one week. We will keep members updated via email from the MyCourts booking system nearer the date.

IMPORTANT NEWS FROM ENGLAND SQUASH!



18th August 2024 is the last day that you can register with England Squash as a club member and receive the benefits associated with it. This will take you through to November 2024 when direct membership is introduced by them.

From the 19th August 2024 England Squash are introducing their new membership scheme which means that players will need to directly register with England Squash, and pay their membership fee directly to them. If you are already registered with England Squash then your club membership will run to November 2024 and your direct membership will be due then. You need to be registered so that you can retain all the important membership benefits, like insurance and league eligibility, and be kept up-to-date with all of the changes to your individual membership.
