GUEST COACH AT JUNIOR SQUASH SESSIONS

We welcomed <u>Paul Johnson</u> to one of the recent Saturday morning junior coaching sessions at the club, with both the younger and older juniors getting some expert coaching tips on how to improve their technique and their game play. Since retiring from playing Paul's coaching career includes being England Senior and Junior National Squad Coach (2002-2005) and Consultant Professional Squash Coach, USA (2005-2014)

Paul is an ex professional player who played at the highest level. He is an ex British Champion, and he reached a career-high world ranking of World No. 4 in 1999. At the 1998 Commonwealth Games, he won a gold medal for England in Kuala Lumpur in the men's doubles, and a bronze medal in the men's singles. Currently Paul is one of the main <u>PSA SquashTV</u> commentators, together with <u>Joey Barrington</u>.

An interesting conversation Paul had with the Duke of Edinburgh at the 1998 Commonwealth Games:

"During the doubles final in Malaysia in 1998 Mark Chaloner and I had just taken the opening game against the Aussies. Mark and I were getting some advice from our coaches when we were suddenly surrounded by bodies. It was the duke's security team and he wanted to come over and have a chat with us. Not exactly the ideal time for that obviously, but after standing to his attention he turned around and said *"my, it looks jolly crowded in there lads, best of luck for the rest of the match".* I mumbled something like *"yes it is sir but fortunately we have a pretty good idea of what we're doing so it's not too bad".* He smiled, nodded and went on his way. I spent the rest of the interval more worried about what I'd said and sounding like a idiot than what DP had to say.

Oh, we bashed the Aussies up 3-0 by the way!"

Please also ensure that you always **add your opponent(s)** to your booking in the MyCourts booking system. If you are using the court for solo practice, please select **"Solo Play"** as your opponent from the membership directory.

2024-2025 Membership & Light Fees

The Annual General Meeting of the club was held on 22nd August 2024 and the meeting discussed the membership fees and light fees for the following year. At the meeting the committee made the decision to freeze the membership fees and light fees for yet another year. For the period 2024-2025 these will remain at £120 p.a. for full membership, £48.50 for off-peak membership and £20 for junior membership. The last time the full annual membership fee was increased was in 2019, and since then RPI inflation has seen a 33% increase and CPI inflation 24%, so keeping the membership and court fees at last year's level we feel is very good value and we encourage members to take a direct England Squash membership (see below). PLEASE NOTE: Your club membership no longer includes England Squash membership fees as they have adopted a direct model of membership rather than through affiliated squash clubs. The committee recommend that you either take a direct membership of England Squash at their "Just Play", "Play Plus" or "Junior" memberships as applicable, as these membership types include up to £10 million of public liability and personal accident cover (including dental, hospital costs, physio and x-ray), or that if you don't sign up to one of the above England Squash membership types you consider taking out your own sports insurance that covers you playing squash.

From November 2024 members will also need to take up England Squash membership directly.
